





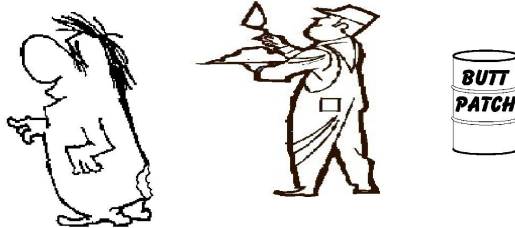
Kitchen News
